Job Description

Role and Responsibilities:

We are looking for a full-time Project Manager to manage green compliance projects for our customers. Compliance projects will deal with global product regulations such as EU REACH, EU RoHS, Conflict Minerals and others. The Project Manager's goal is to manage customers' expectations and ensure customer satisfaction.

Ideal candidates should have a background in electronic hardware design and/or knowledge of component engineering (BOM, materials, substances, etc.).

Typical duties include but are not limited to:

- Accomplishes project team objectives by orienting, training, assigning, scheduling, coaching, counseling, and communicating job expectations; planning, monitoring, appraising, and reviewing job contributions; planning and reviewing compensation actions; enforcing policies and procedures.
